Devotional Thought From the Pastor... From Glory to Glory

2 Corinthians 3:18, "We . . . are being transformed into his image with ever-increasing glory."

Living in a coastal town, Valerie loved warm weather, wildlife photography, and being in the water. Above all, she loved watching the sunrise over the ocean. Every morning, she woke up before dawn to catch a view of the water. Val estimated that despite cloudy weather or travel, she still managed to see more than three hundred waterfront sunrises each year. She never tired of watching them. In her eyes, the sunrise held a glory she didn't want to miss.

In Exodus 34, we read about Moses' radiant face literally reflecting his glorious encounter with Lord" (vv. 29-35). Paul said that since Jesus came, there's an even more glorious ministry than what Moses experienced (2 Corinthians 3:7-8). It's the ministry of the Spirit, which brings righteousness (vv. 8-9). God's plan of salvation has permanent glory, surpassing anything that came before (v. 10), and we get to participate in it. The apostle said, "We all, who with unveiled faces contemplate the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his image with everincreasing glory" (v. 18). That everincreasing glory is not dependent on how well we perform but on the Holy Spirit. We, like the clouds at sunrise, just reflect a little more and a little better each day the glorious work that He's doing.

2 Timothy 2:1-7, Philippians 3:3-4, Philippians 3:5-10

Be Rooted In Christ's Grace

- Paul knows Timothy is facing plenty of challenging circumstances and people.
- •You do not have to find your security and strength in proving anything.
- •When we wake up each day and try to prove our own merit, we will be depending on something that we can never fulfill.
- •God has already provided, so if we choose to find our confidence in the grace of Christ then we have a source of strength that no person or circumstance can take away.

Invest In Others

- •At the end of our earthly lives, it will not be our possessions that matter; it will be the difference we made in other people's lives.
- •Paul understood that lives are natural networks with families and friends.
- •Paul understood the exponential power of one.
- •Paul urges us to pass on what we learn in any way we might share it.
- •The average person influences 10,000 people throughout their lifetime.

Accept What Is Required To Fulfill What Matters Most

- •Paul doesn't want Timothy to suffer but be accepting of what is required to fulfill what matters most.
- •We should embrace that which we are now part of, an eternal kingdom.
- •It is worth embracing the rules so that what we achieve is legitimate.
- •God calls us to work the field of our own lives.

Conclusion

- Paul says, "I am now chained like a criminal," but God's Word is not chained."
- •They may chain the messenger or even kill the messenger, but they cannot stop the Gospel message.
- •Paul was killed within weeks, silenced, by the empire to end all empires, and here we are 2,000 years later gathering around the Gospel he shared.
- •God is unstoppable!
