Products of Temptation

- The four products of temptation are:

 - Sincerity It is impossible to inherit God's kingdom without a childlike faith.
 - Equality Temptation reduces everyone to the same level.
 - Longevity A person must endure temptation in order to be found worthy to receive the Crown of Life.
- The products of temptation represent the character-building Christians need to prepare themselves for eternity.

Necessity of Temptation

- The greatest product of our temptation is our standing with Christ when he returns.
- God, in His holiness, cannot experience temptation, nor does He dole it out to his children.
- God never tempts us to see if we will fall.
- Our human lusts are the sources of our temptations.
- The only way we can overcome the temptations brought on by our lusts is through Jesus Christ.
- We must deal with the source of our temptations directly and daily.

Good Gifts

- If a gift is truly good and truly perfect, then it has to come from God.
- God is called the "Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning."
- God has no dark side because. His nature will not permit him to do bad things.
- There is no hidden agenda in God's plans.
- God can only give gifts that bring light to our lives.
